Bred-by-Exhibitor (BBE) Class Eligibility: All dogs entered in the Bred-by-Class must be individually registered with AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

Best of Breed: The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90 day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC.

Move-Ups: Dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one-half hour prior to the start of judging at the show.

Veteran: Open to dogs and bitches 7 years old or over. Winners from these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Veteran Classes at independent specialty shows.

Field Trial Dog: For dogs and bitches who have a placement in the Senior Stakes or a First in Derby Stakes at an AKC Licensed Field Trial.

Hunting Dog: For dogs and bitches who have achieved the GSCA WD or WDR title or an AKC Junior Hunter, Senior Hunter or Master Hunter title.

Stud Dog Class: For Stud Dogs and two of their Get Stud dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with their Get Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be the owner of the Get The Get must be entered individually in one of the regular classes, Best of Breed, or some non-regular class other than Stud Dog. Judging will be based on the merits of the Get.

Brood Bitch Class: For Brood Bitches and two of their Produce. Brood Bitch must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and shown in the ring with their Produce. Owner of the Brood Bitch need not necessarily be the owner of the Produce. The Produce must be entered individually in one of the regular classes, Best of Breed, or some non-regular class other than Brood Bitch. Judging will be based on the merits of the Produce.

Brace Class: Each Brace shall be composed of two Gordon Setters, irrespective of sex, owned by an identical owner. Entry Fee is \$28.00 for the unit. If the dog that is part of the Brace is not entered in another Class, it must be entered for "Brace Class only." Show Brace Class in "Additional Entry" portion of the entry form. If more than one Brace is entered by identical owner, the dog comprising each Brace Unit must be designated "Brace #1, Brace#2, Etc.

Note: As the Judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch and Brace Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

Junior Showmanship Competition

Novice Junior Class: For boys and girls at least 9 and under 12 years old on the day of the show who, at the time entries close, have not won 3 first places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate Class: For boys and girls at least 12 and under 15 years old on the day of the show who, at the time entries close, have not won 3 first places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class: For boys and girls at least 15 and under 18 years old on the day of the show who, at the time entries close, have not won 3 first places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class: For boys and girls at least 9 and under 12 years old on the day of the show who, at the time entries close, have won 3 first places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Intermediate Class: For boys and girls at least 12 and under 15 years old on the day of the show who, at the time entries close, have won 3 first places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Senior Class: For boys and girls at least 15 and under 18 years old on the day of the show who, at the time entries close, have won 3 first places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

- There will be no overnight camping on the show grounds.
- The show site will be available to exhibitors at 7:00 AM on October 12, 2009.
- Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following close of show. There is ample shaded parking available on the show grounds.
- Exhibitors, owners, and agents assume all responsibility for dogs and equipment on the show site.
- Each exhibitor is responsible for keeping his grooming and exercise area clean and orderly. All waste must be cleaned up and properly disposed before leaving the site. See page 2 for instructions for entries. Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as practical with tickets and/or identification cards.
- No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. **NO TELEPHONE, TELEGRAPH OR UNSIGNED ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.** Entries not on an official AKC Entry Form and photocopies of Entry Forms without agreement and rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE.**
- Errors on Entry Blanks: Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fees will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by e-mail prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone **are not acceptable.** There will be no refund of duplicate entries. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.
- Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee or cancellation of a win by the American Kennel Club. No entry fee will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an Act of God, public emergency, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the club.
- **JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS.** They will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for the presence of their dogs in the ring when their classes are called to be judged.
- The TarTan Gordon Setter Club, Inc., assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
- A recording fee of \$.50 and an event services fee of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or member club show or obedience trial. These event service and recording fees are to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, these Fees are to be collected on the first entry only (American Kennel Club Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2).
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. The TarTan Gordon Setter Club, Inc., recommends that all dogs traveling to shows be current on all regular vaccines. Be aware that Connecticut has Lyme disease. Although the autumn months have fewer ticks, be sure to check your dogs and avoid exercising dogs in tall grassy areas and evergreen woods.

AGREEMENT

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. - 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
