Field Trial Class: For Dogs and bitches who have a placement in the Senior Stakes (Example, Gun Dog or All Age) or a first in Derby Stakes or at a AKC Licensed Field Trial.

Hunting Dog/Bitch Class: For those Dogs/Bitches who have achieved the GSCA WD/WDR Title, or the AKC Junior Hunter, Senior Hunter or Master Hunter Titles,

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dogs

Stud Dog: For Stud Dog and two of their Get. Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown with their Get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not be the owner of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the Standard for its Breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best Of Breed competition or some other Non-Regular class. The entry must be marked in the additional class on the entry form.

Brood Bitch: The same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Brace Class: (For Two dogs, of the same breed with one owner in common) The dogs comprising a Brace **Must Be Named** at the time of entry. If a dog, which is part of the Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Only" under additional Class and full particulars given on the entry form. If more than one brace is entered by the same identical owner, each entrant must be designated "Brace1", "Brace 2", etc.

Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising pen.

Class cash prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging is over. The Show Secretary, and the Gordon Setter Club of Michigan disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging is over. All trophies will be awarded in the ring. No trophies will be mailed.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of The Show Committee. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color). Beagles (not exceeding 13 in. over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard), Collies (rough, smooth).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition; Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed.
